



THE SOCRATES ANNUAL FELLOWSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

While our system automatically saves your work as you go, we recommend that you prepare your up-loadable application materials – detailed below – in advance and prior to entering the online application.

Note: Required fields are noted with an asterisk (*).

1. PERSONAL INFO*

Complete the first section that asks: 1) name*; 2) date of birth*; 3) place of birth*; 4) mailing address*; 5) telephone number*; and 6) email address*. Please also indicate your 8a) gender (optional); and 8b) ethnicity (optional); 9) whether you previously submitted a proposal to Socrates Sculpture Park*; and 10) whether you are currently based in New York City.*

We ask information about gender and ethnicity because many of our funders ask.

2. PROFESSIONAL INFO*

Upload your most current resume as a PDF. Resume should include information about your education; exhibition history; awards, grants, and residencies; and details of any published writings.

File formats accepted: PDF, DOC, or DOCX

3. PAST WORK*

3.a WORK SAMPLE LIST*

Upload a numbered list that corresponds to each of the 10 files submitted. For each image, include the title, date, materials, and dimensions. A two-sentence description of each work is optional.

File formats accepted: PDF, DOC, or DOCX, Must be under 1MB

3.b Upload (10) WORK SAMPLES*

Work samples should be of recent work, particularly work that relates to your proposal for Socrates Sculpture Park. These images are in addition to any images submitted as part of the project proposal.

File formats accepted: JPG, TIFF, MP3, WAV, MP4 and MOV.

4. PROPOSAL (S)*

You may submit up to two specific proposals or versions of the same proposal with your application.

4.a WRITTEN DESCRIPTION*

Enter a written description of the work - up to 900 words - that you would like to produce and exhibit at Socrates Sculpture Park. This written description should focus on the following: 1) overall concept; 2) use and durability of materials for outdoor environment and 3) relationship of proposed project to your artistic practice.

4.b PROPOSAL IMAGES AND MATERIALS*

Upload a single file of up to three pages with drawings, plans, or renderings.

File formats accepted: PDF, DOC, or DOCX, JPG, or TIFF.

5. PROPOSAL BUDGET*

Upload a realistic budget for materials and production. This should also include a line for the artist

honorarium within the \$5,000 budget total.

File formats accepted: PDF, DOC, or DOCX.

6. POTENTIAL PROGRAMMING

Please share ideas for potential public programming or performance elements that may complement the Park's already existing special event and public programming that occur throughout the summer and fall. This is not required. For reference, browse past year's seasonal program calendars: socratessculpturepark.org/publications

7. REFERENCES*

Provide two names, emails and phone numbers of people familiar with your work.

8. SUBMIT*

Once all material is entered and uploaded, click SUBMIT. You will receive an email confirming receipt of the application after completion.
